Please note that individual trees are not identified with anyone's name. Permanent records are kept, however, at the main office in Formosa. They can be viewed at any time during regular business hours (8:30 am - 4:30 pm). A permanent plaque has also been erected at the main grove at Sulphur Spring Conservation Area (formerly Headquarters C.A). It includes *all* the names of the deceased, from all of the groves and forests across the watershed.

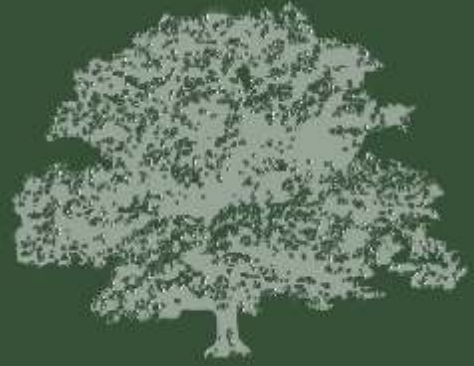
Anyone contributing towards the planting of a tree, as well as the family of the deceased, will also be invited to an annual Memorial Grove Ceremony at Sulphur Spring Conservation Area (formerly Headquarters C.A). The Ceremony is held each year in June.

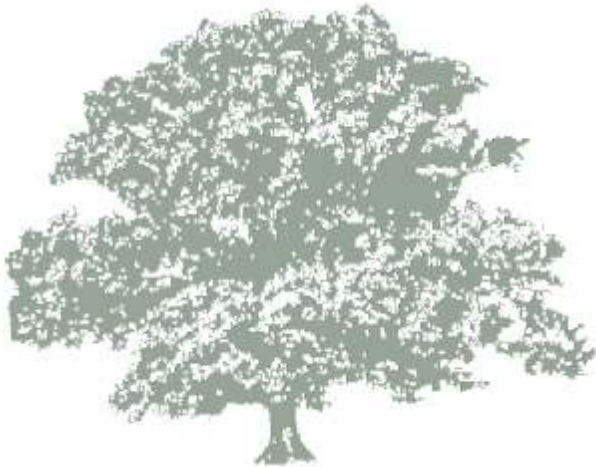
